COVID-19 Policies & Procedures *

2021 - 2022 School Year

Face coverings are optional for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

When considered a Close Contact:
(15 or more minutes consecutive or cumulative within 6 ft of a COVID-19 positive person within a 24-hour period)

Fully Vaccinated?
(2 weeks after 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine,
or 2 weeks after single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine)

- If you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 3 months, you will not be required to quarantine unless symptoms develop. *(documentation required)*
- Monitor for symptoms
- No quarantine required unless symptoms develop or positive test received.
- Recommend testing 3-5 days after exposure
- Recommend face covering for 14 days or until negative test result received any time after 3rd day of exposure
- If symptoms develop and/or positive test received, quarantine required for 10 days from last exposure

- If you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 3 months, you will not be required to quarantine unless symptoms develop. *(documentation required)*
- Monitor for symptoms
- Quarantine for 14 days from last exposure **if** presenting with symptoms
- Quarantine for 10 days from last exposure without symptoms. Face-covering and symptom monitoring **required** through day 14.
- If negative test result was collected on or after day 5 of quarantine, quarantine may end after day 7. Face-covering and symptom monitoring **required** through day 14.
- If positive test received, quarantine for 10 days from onset of symptoms or test date if no symptoms

High-Risk Symptoms	Low-Risk Symptoms	
- Consistent Cough	- Fever ($\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$) or Chills	- Headache
- Shortness of Breath	- Congestion or Runny Nose	- Fatigue
- New Loss of Taste or Smell	- Muscle or Body Aches	- Diarrhea
	- Nausea or Vomiting	

When presenting with 1 or more high-risk symptom(s) or 2 or more low-risk symptoms:

Student or staff will be required to:
1) quarantine for 10 days OR
2) get tested for COVID-19 OR
3) follow medical advice from provider

requirement:
Quarantine for 10 days
from onset of symptoms;
