## 2018 HURLEY HIGH SCHOOL DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

CESA #2 is assisting Hurley High School with the Drivers' Education Program. For your convenience, students may attain a Wisconsin driver's license through a program offered by CESA #2, at the Hurley High School campus, both during the school year and during the summer.

Driver Education is a foundation course, which teaches the theory of responsible driving, defensive driving, and emphasis is placed on the introduction of the proper safety mechanics of safe driving. The course is designed to improve the student's knowledge of traffic safety and to become safe operators of motor vehicles. The course covers all areas of vehicle operation, legal obligations, maintenance, effects of alcohol and other drugs, with a strong emphasis on distractive driving.

### PROGRAM COST

**Traditional Classroom \$150.00-** Driver Education is a foundation course which teaches the theory of responsible driving. Emphasis is placed upon introduction of mechanics of driving, execution of most driving operations, and a thorough understanding of rules of safe driving. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction.

Students that attend the class without registering with CESA # 2 will not receive instruction. CESA #2 must obtain parental consent to provide Driver Education services to your child.

CESA #2 requires information on any special needs that your child might have i.e. hearing impaired, ADD, IEP's, juvenile diabetes, etc. We will do our best to accommodate the needs for your child's success.

**Online Class Course \$175.00-** The Online Driver Education course offered by CESA #2 provides a unique opportunity for students that have busy schedules to learn critical skills needed to become a safe, low-risk driver. Our program is one of few that meet the National and State Standards for online learning. Your child will have an instructor to work with them throughout the course.

On-line Course Required Textbook: This course is based on the AAA's book, How to Drive. **This book must be purchased** and is not provided through CESA2. How to Drive is offered as a soft-cover book or an e-book. There is a \$50.00 fee for all on-line extensions.

No refunds will be issued after one year from the date of registration. There is a \$25.00 processing fee for all refunds during the one-year period.

**NEW! Pulse Driving \$99.00- Optional** This is a highly recommended optional post Driver Education Course. The course is designed to be used by students once they have completed driver education and have their license. In education, once classes have been finished, the learning ends. Many important topics start to fade in the students' memory over time. The Pulse Driving course is meant to 'refresh' the memory of students on important aspects of driving during the critical first year they have their license. There are no refunds for Pulse Driving.

### ENROLLMENT PROCESS

**State of Wisconsin Driver Education age requirements:** The student must be 15 years old to enter classroom and pass the Instructional Permit tests provided during the classroom session. The student must be a minimum of 15-1/2 years old to obtain an Instructional Permit from the State of Wisconsin DMV. Students must be attending class or complete the on-line course to be eligible for the Instructional Permit.
