Dear Parents/Guardians:

CESA 2 is our provider for driver education services for the Hurley School District. You will not be registering or paying the Hurley School District for driver education. All course registration and payments will be sent to CESA 2. LawDogs driving school will be providing the driving portion of the program. Please carefully read the following for a summary of items you need to consider for your child's driver education.

Required March 21st parent meeting: All freshmen, even if you won't be taking online until summer 2018 or later in the fall. If your child is already enrolled in the online course and has not already started driving or made driving arrangements, you must attend this meeting. If you are actively driving behind the wheel with LawDogs it is not necessary to attend

All classroom/online registration and payments will be sent to CESA 2 either by mail or by registering online and paying online with credit or debit card. Course fees are as follows: Traditional classroom (summer school) \$150 or Online course \$175.

Registering for driver education classroom or online can be done by either completing the attached registration form and sending it along with payment to CESA 2 through the mail, or going online and registering (see attached registration form for more detailed information). Again, you may pay by mailing a check with your registration or paying online with a credit or debit card.

Behind the wheel driving (BTW) will be provided by LawDogs driving school, fee is \$250 and will payable to LawDogs NOT CESA 2.

If you have questions about the process, please wait until the March 21st parent/student meeting, we will address questions/concerns at that time. The summer school session will begin Monday, June 11, 2018 and end on June 28, 2018 (9am-11:30am). At this time, CESA 2 would like to know which students would like to be included in the summer Drivers Education Program so instructor schedules can be prepared for this summer. There will be one required meeting prior to the end of the school year on Wednesday, March 21st (parent/student). This meeting will address driver education curriculum and will be counted towards your child's 30 classroom hours.

Students will receive 30 hours of classroom instruction during the summer school session. LawDogs Driving school will be providing behind the wheel training and will be present at the Wednesday, March 21st meeting to explain their process to register and pay for BTW.

Payment of **\$150 (traditional classroom) or \$175 (online)** must be paid prior to the start of the course. If payment is not received by the start of the course (June 11th), the student will be removed from the program. **Again, LawDogs Driving School will provide BTW training and payments for that portion of driver training will be paid to them directly, not CESA 2.**

If you are planning a summer vacation, please consider the dates of the driver education program if your child is to participate. Attendance is mandatory. You are allowed one (1) absence (required March meeting is included as part of the course), if you miss more than 1 day (includes parent/student meeting), you will be withdrawn from the program. If you do have a scheduling issue with the traditional classroom course (June 11th-28th) consider the online option if it is appropriate for your child.

NOTE: In the event of excessive snow days resulting in an extension of the regular school year the course start date and schedule will be adjusted. You will receive separate notice of this at the parent/guardian meeting in March.

There will be one required meeting prior to the Monday, June 11th start date:

**Wednesday, March 21st, 2018 from 6:00-7:30 p.m. in the high school auditorium
(A parent/guardian must attend this meeting along with the student)**

**Classroom Dates: Monday, June 11 through Thursday June 28; Monday-Thursday
9:00-11:30AM**

At this time CESA 2 will not be providing testing for temporary licenses, students may go directly to the DMV to take the temps test.
